Our Time-Tested Model How the Internship Program Works



Semester Internship/Co-Op

Fall or Spring Semester Duration: About 14 weeks, 32 hours per week (duration can be altered for co-op model)

Credits Earned: 12
Number Completed: One (junior or senior year)
Additional Requirements:

Class one day per week for 14 weeks

Semester Internship Strategies*

Instruction provided junior year prepares students to succeed in semester-long internship their senior year..

*Portfolio course for visual and performing arts majors.

Pre-internship Sessions

Instruction provided first or second semester during year one prepares students to search for and complete their first and second internships. These sessions also take place online sophomore year.

Short-term Internship

Summer or Winter

Duration: About three weeks/minimum of 120 hours

Credits Earned: Two for each **Number Completed:** Two

(One freshman year and one sophomore year)

Undergraduate Career Plan



Make the connection between major and career.

- Meet with Internship & Career Center to discuss career plans.
- Complete Pre-Internship Class (INT 010) and your first-year internship experience (INT 100).
- Meet with internship faculty to plan/search for your first internship.
- If you interned during winter break, meet with your academic advisor to reflect on the experience and plan for your next internship.
- Get involved with campus activities, clubs, and community service projects.
- Start discussing options for studying and interning abroad with your faculty advisor so you can plan your courses in advance.



Continue to grow and explore personally, professionally, and academically.

- Meet with Internship & Career Center to clarify career plans and choice of major.
- Complete Pre-Internship Class (INT 020) online and your second-year internship experience (INT 200).
- Meet with internship faculty to plan/search for second internship.
- Meet with academic advisor to reflect on the experience and plan for next internship.
- Seek leadership positions in clubs, athletics, and college and community organizations.



Zero in on your career goals and secure a semester-long internship.

- Complete Semester Internship Strategies or Portfolio Class.
- Meet with internship faculty to plan/search for semester internship.
- Continue your involvement and leadership in extracurricular activities and community service.
- If you are considering graduate school, start to research programs and application requirements.



Evolve

Work on landing your first job or preparing/applying for graduate school.

- Meet with Internship & Career Center staff to clarify your career plans.
- Complete Semester Internship & Seminar (480).
- Build your network by attending professional development programs and career fairs.
- Consider enrolling in EC400 Senior Transitions which prepares you to be a well rounded professional and sets you up for success post graduation.

Endicott College Madrid

Through Endicott's Madrid campus, students are able to study abroad as well as complete semester internships at organizations that offer opportunities that fit a wide range of majors. Examples of past internship sites include ADM Sports, Be Madrid, PA Team, Audaxi, MadCap, La Casita De Engels, Neurored, Mercedarias de Don Juan Luis de Alarcón, and many more.

Semester in the City-an AmeriCorps Partner

Students will intern with a nonprofit, social mission business, or government agency in Boston for 30 hours per week. Semester in the City works with students to place them in internships aligned with their interests, be it criminal justice reform, education, gender equality, sustainability, and beyond.

Washington Internship Institute

Students can intern and live in Washington, D.C., with the Washington Internship Institute in settings like federal agencies, congressional offices, embassies, businesses, and a variety of nonprofit and advocacy organizations. Housing is included and located just minutes from outside of the city.

New York Film Academy

Students can take advantage of internship opportunities in film and media, performing arts, and visual arts in New York, Los Angeles, Miami, or abroad in Florence, Italy, or Gold Coast, Australia. Spend the semester fully immersed in the arts through hands-on experience with industry leaders.
